A Class:

Porsche lightweight cars with engine power above 475 h.p. (except 997.1 Turbo), "ready for race" cars, lightened cars belong to this class no matter of models and engine powers, any type of tuning and modifications are accepted, any type of tires are allowed (including Slick tires). If more than 3 GT2 RS or cup cars will participated in race, A Class will split to A and A + for GT RS2 or Cup Cars. But they will drive together on same session.

B Class:

Porsche lightweight cars with engine power from 356 h.p. to 474 h.p., light modifications allowed (brakes, suspension, exhaust and e.t.c.), tires allowed with wear index not lower than 180.

C Class:

Porsche lightweight cars with engine power below 355 h.p., light modifications allowed (brakes, suspension, exhaust and e.t.c.), tires allowed with wear index not lower than 200.

D Class:

Porsche classic cars manufactured before year 1996, sedans and SUV`s, as well models Boxster/Cayman below 299 h.p., light modifications are allowed (brakes, suspension, exhaust and e.t.c.), tires allowed with wear index not lower than 200.
